The Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 and the Manual Handling Operations Regulations 1992 requires employers to provide their employees with all relevant health and safety training, including safe manual handling.

The most recent studies and surveys of self-reported work-related illness estimated that in 2001/02, 1.1 million people in Great Britain suffered from musculoskeletal disorders (MSDs) caused or made worse by their current or past work. An estimated 12.3 million working days were lost due to these work-related MSDs. On average each sufferer took about 20 days off in that 12 month period.
